Roxboro completes maintenance outage - over 7,000 hours of safe and successful work

Workers recently completed a planned maintenance outage. The team at the plant, along with an average of 64 contractors, worked consecutively on the nine-day outage compiling more than 7,000 hours without a single safety or environmental incident.

The major work was focused on overhauling two of the facility's three stoker grates within the plant's boilers, service of the bottom ash drag-chain equipment, and inspection of the high-energy piping within the boiler. Additional work included repairs to the site's wood, tire-derived-fuel handling system and service of the fly ash conditioner at the ash silo.

"The inspection work that has been performed over the past couple of years has revealed some areas, mostly within the boilers, requiring additional repairs. With support from subject-matter experts in the company, we could make the necessary repairs, return the plant to operation, and maintain a high level of availability." - David Hayward, Plant Manager

Contributing to the outages' positive safety performance, the team focused on daily housekeeping to maintain a safe workplace. This included clearing clutter and immediately clearing up spills and leaks to prevent possible slip, trip, and fall incidents. Additionally, greater emphasis was placed on contractor safety through site inspections and Field Level Hazard Identification (FLH) audits. The team also utilized the services of local off-duty fire fighters to provide confined space support and make rounds looking for potential safety-related issues. Not only do the fire fighters provide support, they learned the layout of the facility, take knowledge if ever responding to a fire or other emergency on site.
